## **Logix in the Community**

### **Logix Community Stars Foundation**

[Logix Community Stars Foundation](#) was started in 2007 by Logix employees to support local charities through financial donations and volunteerism. Through employee payroll contributions, fundraisers and donations, the foundation distributes funds to four nonprofit partners: [Burbank Temporary Aid Center](#), [For The Troops](#), [Penny Lane Centers](#) and [Circle of Hope](#). ### **Donation Matching**

Logix also offers a donation-matching program for employees who make contributions through payroll deduction. Additionally, the foundation hosts fundraising campaigns online and/or in the branches.

### **Volunteer Time Off**

In addition to charitable giving, Logix employees participate in paid Volunteer Time Off each year. We regularly team up with organizations to lend a hand stuffing care packages, brighten up a room with a fresh coat of paint, provide staffing for major fundraising events, or even serving as principal for a day.

### **12 Days of Giving**

Wrapping up a difficult year on a high note in 2020, Logix Federal Credit Union created the 12 Days of Giving to support students in the Conejo Valley Unified School District (CVUSD) by gifting \$1,000 to one local school daily from December 14 to December 25.

### **Valley Industry Association's Connecting to Success**

Connecting to Success is a preparation program for high school juniors and seniors in the Santa Clarita Valley. With the Valley Industry Association, the credit union has helped champion this project for more than a decade. At least, 100 volunteers from the business community facilitate this one-day workshop for students through role-playing, case studies, group discussions, and individual assessments. The goal is to help these students understand the expectations of the workplace and give them the tools to enter the workforce as responsible adults.

### **College of the Canyons**

The Logix/COC Canyon Country Campus Scholarship was created in 2015 for students at College of the Canyons. In 2017, another opportunity was formed, the Kathryn Barger/Logix Scholarship. Students can apply for the scholarship during the application period; and, the selected students are scheduled to receive the award in May.

### **Local Hospitals**

During the last few years, Logix has been a corporate sponsor of Henry Mayo Newhall Hospital. In 2016, one of the credit union employees was welcomed onto the hospital foundation's board of directors. Logix staff also works with Providence Cedars-Sinai Tarzana Medical Center and Dignity Northridge Medical Center to provide support to healthcare workers.
